Frequently Asked Questions

1. I qualified for the second round. When and where will it be held?

Thursday, March 13, same place as the first round. The timing will be different from the first round. Start time is 9 AM. End time is 3 PM. Please contact the local hosts for more information.

2. I have a conflict on the day of the second round. Can I take the test another day?

No, the second round can only be taken on March 13. If your **entire site** has a conflict for just part of the day (e.g. the American Invitational Math Examination), it may hold NACLO at another time zone's time, with prior permission from the NACLO organizing committee.

3. What is the maximum score in the first round? What about the average?

The maximum score happened to be 91.382% this year. The average was 43.258%.

4. How will the US (Canadian) teams be selected?

USA: The top four performers on the second round will be invited to one US team. Another four students will be invited to a second US team pending funding and ILO approval and will be chosen at the discretion of the team coaches, based on scores in rounds 1 and 2. Additional students may be invited to team practices as alternates.

Canada: The procedure will be announced before the second round.
