(K) Dyirbal

Word orders:

- SOV in case the subject is a pronoun
- OSV in case the subject is not a pronoun

Pronouns:

- ŋinda = you
- ŋađa = I

Definite articles:

- bayi, placed before subjects of intransitive verbs and objects of transitive verbs
- bangul, placed before subjects of transitive verbs.

The suffix -ŋgu is placed on the subject of transitive verbs, when the subject is not a pronoun.

<u>Assignment 1.</u> Give the English translations: bayi ñalŋga banagañu **= The boy returned.** bayi yaŗa baŋgul yuŗiŋgu walmbin. **= The kangaroo waked the man.** ŋinda bayi yuŗi buŗan. **= You saw the kangaroo.**

<u>Assignment 2.</u> Give the Dyirbal translations:

You sat. **= ŋinda ñinañu** I caught the kangaroo. **= ŋađa bayi yuṛi ñiman.** The father waked the man **= bayi yaṛa baŋgul ŋumaŋgu walmbin.**
