Notes: Some two-character sequences, like tl, dl, kw, gw, and ts, are treated as single letters in the Kwak'wala alphabet.  $\underline{a}$  represents an "uh" sound.  $\underline{k}$  and g are pronounced like "k" and hard "g", but with the tongue further back in the mouth. x is pronounced like the "h" in "human", and  $\underline{x}$  like the "ch" in "Bach". An apostrophe indicates that the sound is pronounced with increased pressure at the back of the throat.
