

(H) Can you know / Hanunó'o? (1/1) [15 Points]

Hanunó'o is an abugida that, unusually, reads bottom to top rather than top to bottom. By default, full letters represent consonants + *a*. Lines above or below the letter change the vowel to *i* or *u*. A curved line to the bottom right of the letter (*padmudpod*) represents the absence of a vowel. Note that *a* and *i* on their own have their own letters, *ɿ* and *ʷ*.
