### Explanation:

Writing direction is left to right.

Syllable-initial consonants are written with full letters:

𠄎 *k-*, 𠄎 *kh-*, 𠄎 *ch-*, 𠄎 *t-*, 𠄎 *th-*, 𠄎 *d-*, 𠄎 *b-*, 𠄎 *ts-*, 𠄎 *r-*, 𠄎 *l-*

If there is no initial consonant, the null initial 𠄎 is used instead.

Vowels are marked by symbols to the left of, below, or to the right of consonants:

𠄎 *ke*, 𠄎 *ki*, 𠄎 *ko*, 𠄎 *kó*, 𠄎 *ku*, 𠄎 *kú*

If there is no vowel mark, by default the vowel *a* is used: 𠄎 *ka*.

Syllable-final consonants are written with symbols above or to the left of the consonant-vowel block:

𠄎 *kak*, 𠄎 *kan*, 𠄎 *kat*, 𠄎 *kang*
